### NEW VACCINE REQUIREMENTS

Students entering the 7<sup>th</sup> grade are **required to have 1 dose of the Meningococcal vaccine** if born on or after September 15, 2004. There will be no grace period allowed, if your child does not meet the state requirements they will not be allowed to start school on August 23. If your student has a **medical exemption**; a new medical exemption to include the Meningococcal vaccine is required. **YOU MUST PROVIDE THIS INFORMATION TO YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL AS SOON AS POSSIBLE!**

Tina Miller provided an updated budget report for 2016-2017 school year. The current bank balance is \$17,793.41. The PTA has \$4,422.73 remaining in the 2016-2017 budget. \$4,000 has been allocated for the Library art mural & soft seating furniture.

A proposed revised budget for the 2017-2018 school year was presented. The PTA added a line item for Lego League as well as an accounting program, Money Minder, for the PTA. The budget for the 2017-2018 was approved.

**Grandparent's Day:** Grandparent's day was held on Friday, May 5<sup>th</sup>. Approximately 200 bottles of water were provided by the PTA for the guests.

**Box Tops:** Tina reported that our current total for Box Tops is \$1,434.15. The PTA recently received a check for \$258.60 from Box Tops.

**Walk-A-Thon:** The walk-a-thon raised \$4,137.14. The money was used to purchase the new soft seating and mural for the Library.

**Staff Appreciation:** The PTA provided meals and treats for the staff during the week of May 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> for staff appreciation week. The PTA received a thank you card from the staff.

**Bonanza Planning:** Jen DeBuhr has begun submitting online donation requests for Bonanza's silent auction items. Jen is reaching out for more volunteers to help with Bonanza's fundraising committee.

**Principal's Report**

Mrs. Behrer thanked the PTA for all their efforts over her last 2 years at Bridgeview.

All students must register online this school year. Online registration for the 2017-2018 school year is open until May 15<sup>th</sup>. Mrs. Behrer reported to date that 35% of students have registered district-wide.

The end of the year event will be held on Friday, May 26<sup>th</sup>. The students will have a picnic lunch and activities based around a "Circus" theme. The school will need a total of 8 parent volunteers to help with relay races and applying fake tattoos.

### **Old Business**

**Sensory Stools:** Mrs. Albrecht, school counselor, received her 5 sensory stools for a total cost of \$414.21. The stools are being used to help children maintain focus and attention while in the classrooms. The PTA approved up to \$425.00 for the sensory stools.

### **New Business**

**Library Seating:** The walk-a-thon funds are being used to purchase furniture for the library. The puzzle shaped furniture pieces that were originally chosen for the library have been discontinued. Ms. Fight provided the PTA with some replacement options, but costs exceeded the original quote by \$300. The PTA approved up to \$300 to purchase 4 round furniture pieces for the library.
