Campers will meet with similar-aged peers daily from 8:30-11:30 a.m. Each group is led by 2 certified classroom teachers who will model writing, share a rich variety of mentor texts, and offer ideas and techniques for advancing writing skills! This camp is not intended for remediation, nor is it restricted to only advanced writers. Anyone who enjoys writing is welcome to attend! Campers will be given freedom of choice for their writing topics, as well as opportunities for peer collaboration and feedback. Each day writers will receive a mid-morning snack. All snacks are nut-free, but you are welcome to bring your own snack if you have dietary concerns.
